

2025-2026 WLC Tuition Support Fund

Overview

The WLC Tuition Support Fund is designed to increase the number of qualified teachers in WLC schools by providing resources to advance coursework and program completion.

The WLC's FY26 Budget Narrative has allocated up to \$400,000 in funding support with a **priority** focus on those enrolled in ARTC programs and/or completing Master's degree programs in high-need areas such as Special Education, Science, and Math.

Applications will become available the week of **September 15, 2025**. The deadline to apply varies by semester:

- Winter 2025 Application Deadline: October 15
- Spring 2026 Application Deadline: November 15
- Summer 2026 Application Deadline: April 15

Eligibility

Educators serving in roles in WLC schools, including teachers, paraprofessionals, and long-term substitute teachers are eligible to apply. Degree programs must be education related and offered by an accredited university.

WLC will review completed applications and prioritize those applicants enrolled in ARTC programs and those in schools with the opportunity to increase the number of certified teachers.

Process

- The application window will open on **September 15**. Review of applications will begin immediately with decisions to be communicated within 14 days of submission.
- WLC staff may reach out to applicants with questions or requesting additional documentation. Employment will be verified.
- Approved applicants will be notified by email. Submission of an application does not guarantee approval.
- Payments will be made directly to the institution from the WLC, and not to the applicant.
